## Who is eligible to register as a Patient?

### • Maryland Residents

Any Maryland resident whose provider recommends medical cannabis as a treatment option for a qualifying medical condition is eligible to register with the Maryland Medical Cannabis Commission (MMCC) as a patient. Qualifying medical conditions include cachexia, anorexia, wasting syndrome, severe pain, severe nausea, seizures, severe or persistent muscle spasms, glaucoma, post-traumatic stress disorder and chronic pain.

### • Non-Maryland Residents

Effective December 14, 2017 the Commission extended the administrative hold on out-of-state patient applicants until further notice. As a result of this hold, out-of-state patient applications will not be reviewed at this time, and applicants who live outside the State may not access medical cannabis at Maryland licensed dispensaries.

### If you are registering yourself as a patient or caregiver, bring:

- Your government ID (driver's license, MVA card, passport or military ID)

**NOTE:** If your government ID does not show your current address, you must also bring **TWO** documents that prove your current address, such as a utility bill, bank statement, rental contract, mortgage statement, or a federal or state document with your name and current address. Documentation must be dated within the past 90 days and we cannot accept forwarded mail.

### If you are registering an adult who will not be present at the Registration Event, bring:

- A passport photo of the applicant. If you cannot get a passport photo taken, you can bring another photo, but please make sure it meets our photo guidelines. (<http://mmcc.maryland.gov/Pages/photo-requirements.aspx>)
- A copy of the applicant's government ID (driver's license, MVA card, passport or military ID)

**NOTE:** If the applicant's government ID does not show his/her current address, you must also bring **TWO** documents that prove his/her current address, such as a utility bill, bank statement, rental contract, mortgage statement, or a federal or state document with his/her name and current address. Documentation must be dated within the past 90 days and we cannot accept forwarded mail.

### If you are registering a minor patient, bring:

- A passport photo of the minor. If you cannot get a passport photo taken, you can bring another photo, but please make sure it meets our photo guidelines. We can take a photo of the minor, if he/she is present at the registration fair.
- A notarized copy of the MMCC Minor Patient Form (<http://mmcc.maryland.gov/Documents/MinorPatientForm.pdf>)
- Birth Certificate, Adoption Papers, or Court Order that establishes you to be the parent or legal guardian of the minor.
- Your government ID (driver's license, MVA card, passport or military ID).

**NOTE:** If your government ID does not show your current address, you must also bring **TWO** documents that prove your current address, such as a utility bill, bank statement, rental contract, mortgage statement, or a federal or state document with your name and current address. Documentation must be dated within the past 90 days and we cannot accept forwarded mail.
