ORDER TERMINATING RESPONDENT’S PROBATION

BACKGROUND

On June 17, 2020, Chesapeake Apothecary, LLC, (“Chesapeake Apothecary” or “Respondent”) entered into a Consent Order with the Maryland Medical Cannabis Commission (“Commission”). The facts and law set forth in the Consent Order are incorporated by reference herein. The June 17, 2020 Consent Order included numerous orders including the following of particular import here:

ORDERED that the Respondent’s license to dispense medical cannabis shall be placed on PROBATION for a period of ONE YEAR from the date of this Order; and it is further [. . .]

ORDERED that within three months prior to the end of the probationary period, the Respondent may petition for termination of its probation and the Commission, or several commissioners meeting as a committee or Case Resolution Conference panel, may terminate or shorten the probation period if the Respondent can demonstrate full and satisfactory compliance with this Order[.]

FINDINGS

Respondent began its period of probation on June 17, 2020. From that date through the present, Respondent has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of probation and has fully complied with nearly all of the terms of the underlying Consent Order.

Respondent has made regular monthly payments to the Commission towards the balance of Respondent's fine of \$100,000. Respondent has paid a total of \$76,500 towards its fine. Respondent is still obligated to pay the balance of its fine in the amount of \$23,500.

ORDER


Based upon the foregoing, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Respondent's probation under the terms of the June 17, 2020 Consent Order is ended; and further

ORDERED that the Respondent shall pay to the Commission the balance of its fine, \$23,500, within thirty days of the date of this Order; and further


