ORDER TERMINATING RESPONDENT’S PROBATION

BACKGROUND

On December 18, 2018, ForwardGro, LLC, (“ForwardGro” or “Respondent”) entered into a Consent Order with the Maryland Medical Cannabis Commission (“Commission”). The facts and law set forth in the Consent Order are incorporated by reference herein. The December 18, 2018 Consent Order included numerous orders including the following of particular import here:

ORDERED After the conclusion of TWO (2) YEARS from the date of this Consent Order, the Respondent may submit a written petition to the Commission requesting termination of probation. After consideration of the petition, the Commission may terminate the Respondent’s probation through an order if the Respondent has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of probation and this Consent Order.

FINDINGS

Respondent began its period of probation on December 18, 2018. From that date through the present, Respondent has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of probation and the underlying Consent Order.

ORDER

Based upon the foregoing, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Respondent’s probation under the terms of the December 18, 2018 Consent Order is ended and that the Respondent has satisfied all terms and conditions as required; and further

ORDERED that this Consent Order is a **PUBLIC DOCUMENT** pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Gen. Prov. § 4-401 *et seq.* (2014).
