



### **DPI resolution on Windows-**

You can also find the DPI of an image on Windows by following these steps:

1. Open File Explorer and navigate to your image.
2. Right-click on the image file and select Properties.
3. Click the Details tab at the top bar.
4. Scroll down to find image Dimensions and the DPI Resolution.

### **DPI resolution on Mac-**

To find the DPI resolution of an image on Mac, you need to use Preview, the default app by following the below steps:

1. Open Finder and navigate to your image.
  2. Right-click or control-click the file and select Open With > Preview.
  3. With Preview open, go to Tools > Show Inspector.
  4. Select General Info from the dialog box, this should be the first tab at the top.
  5. View the image information to find the resolution or click More Info in the second tab at the top to find the DPI.
